### **Project background**

Enterprise Solar GP Inc., on behalf of Enterprise Solar LP, owned by Renewable Energy Systems Canada Inc. (Enterprise Solar) is proposing to build a new substation and transmission line as part of their Enterprise Solar project. To connect their proposed facility to the grid, modifications to AltaLink's existing 161L/180L transmission line are required.

To connect the Enterprise Solar project to the grid, AltaLink is proposing modifications to two existing structures on an existing double circuit 138 kilovolt (kV) transmission line (called 161L/180L). The modifications include the installation of new hardware on the existing structures and may require the replacement of one structure. This transmission line is located within the road allowance south of SW-26-16-25-W4.
