54L Transmission Line Rebuild: Canmore Project update

Thank you for your ongoing participation in the proposed 54L Transmission Line Rebuild: Canmore. We would like to provide you with a project update.

This proposed project involves rebuilding approximately eight kilometres of the existing 54L transmission line that runs between the Canmore Substation and the boundary of Banff National Park.

In October 2021, AltaLink began consulting with stakeholders on the proposed project. Based on feedback received during consultation, we are continuing to investigate different approaches to rebuild the line to minimize impacts while ensuring that a safe and reliable supply of power is available in the area for years to come.

We remain committed to keeping you informed and will provide you with an update when more information is available.

Project background

AltaLink's existing 54L transmission line is a single circuit 138 kilovolt (kV) line located in Canmore and Banff National Park. It was constructed in 1943 and has reached the end of its lifecycle, so we are proposing to rebuild it. Planning for the rebuild of the portion of line in the park is still in early stages and not part of this project.
