890L Capacity Restoration Project Notice of project approval

Thank you for your ongoing participation in the 890L Capacity Restoration Project. The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) approved this project for construction on December 23, 2024.

Next steps

Where construction activities are required to take place on private property, we will contact you in advance to discuss the specific dates and times we will require access to your property.

We plan to begin construction in February 2025 and anticipate construction to be complete in March 2025.

Depending on where you are in relation to the project, you may see or hear:

- noise and construction crews
- transmission structure construction
- wire stringing on the transmission structures

Project background

The Alberta Electric System Operator (AESO) requested that AltaLink modify portions of the existing 890L transmission line to restore it to its designed capacity and meet the growing demand for electricity in the area. AltaLink's project is in the Town of Edson within Yellowhead County.

The project involves:

- replacing four structures with new structures that are similar in appearance
 - The existing structures are between 14 and 17 metres tall, and the new structures will be between 14 and 20 metres tall
- modifying nine structures by replacing hardware

These modifications will ensure sufficient clearance from the ground or other objects and enable the safe operation of the line at its designed capacity.
